
Nov. 12, 2020 | Indonesia - Village Will Not Allow Renovation for Christian Home

A Christian in Indonesia has been told by local officials that she cannot renovate her house if she intends to use it for Christian purposes. The local village council of Ngastemi village sent a letter to the believer telling her that her Christian activities had caused unrest in the village. "It is prohibited to hold Christian meetings and/or prayer meetings ... in order to



create a harmonious atmosphere between people, especially in Karangdami colony," the letter said. Pray that this woman along with other believers in her village will come to an agreement with authorities about practicing their faith.

Community leaders were reluctant to punish Khampang, who is an elder, but they still worked against him, convincing Khampang's wife that his decision was illegal. She refused to sleep in the same bed as him and gave him small portions of food or nothing at all. When Khampang recently met with VOM partners, large tears rolled down his cheeks as he shared how his family had rejected him. Pray that he will be reconciled with his family while staying faithful to Jesus Christ.
